IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendants' Motion is GRANTED.



IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the execution of the Amended Judgment (6:11-md-2299, ECF No. 4856) entered in favor of Plaintiffs Terrence and Susan Allen and against Defendants Takeda Pharmaceutical Company Limited, Takeda
