IN RE: RETROACTIVE APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS TO THE UNITED STATES SENTENCING GUIDELINES REDUCING DRUG OFFENSE LEVELS EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2014

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Pursuant to the provisions of the Criminal Justice Act, Title 18, United States Code, Section 3006A(a)(1) & (c), the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Western District of Louisiana is hereby appointed to represent any defendant to determine whether or not that defendant may qualify for a reduction of sentence and to present any motions or pleadings relative to a reduction, in accordance with the retroactive application of Amendment 782 to the United States Sentencing Guidelines. Should the Office of the Federal Public Defender determine that there is a conflict with regard to its representation of a particular defendant, a Criminal Justice Act panel attorney will be appointed as counsel.

All motions and pleadings seeking a sentence reduction or in opposition to such a reduction shall be filed in the original criminal proceeding. In the event that the sentencing judge in the original proceeding is no longer a member of the Bench of this District and the case has not been previously reassigned, the case shall be reassigned pursuant to this Court's Standing Order 1.62.
