**NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO LOCAL RULES**

Pursuant to Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, public notice is hereby given of proposed amendments to the Local Rules of the United States District Court, Western District of Louisiana. **LR79.3** is proposed to be amended and **LCrR55** is proposed as a new rule. Amendments to the rules with the parts to be added are underlined as follows:

**LR79.3 Disposition of Exhibits**

All exhibits in civil cases in the custody of the Clerk shall be removed within 30 days of the final disposition of the case. The party offering exhibits shall be responsible for their removal and shall give a detailed receipt for the Clerk's records. If the parties or their attorneys fail or refuse to remove the civil exhibits within 30 days, the exhibits may be destroyed or otherwise disposed of by the Clerk.


**LCrR 55 Records**

All exhibits in criminal cases in the custody of the Clerk shall be maintained for purposes of appeal and post conviction relief, until the sentence and any probation conditions imposed have been satisfied.
