NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO LOCAL RULES

Pursuant to Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, public notice is hereby given of proposed amendments to **Local Rule 83.2.2** of the United States District Court, Western District of Louisiana. The original wording of **LR83.2.2** is shown as stricken below and will be replaced by the underlined wording as follows:

LR83.2.2 Eligibility

~~Any member in good standing of the bar of the Supreme Court of Louisiana is eligible for admission to the bar of this court.~~

Any member of the bar of the Supreme Court of Louisiana who is in good standing with that Court is eligible for admission to and practice before this Court. Should any member's status as being in good standing in Louisiana lapse at any date for any reason, then his/her right to practice in this Court shall be deemed lapsed as of the same date. However, any member whose status in good standing lapses for reasons other than disciplinary may, nonetheless, still apply for admission *pro hac vice*.
