The two (2) attorneys that sign your petition **MUST** be members of the Western District of Louisiana Bar. Their signatures must be original. No copied or faxed signatures will be accepted.

We also require that you supply us with your Louisiana Bar Number.

REMIT a check in the amount of \$201.00 with your application. The check should be made payable to "Clerk, U.S. District Court."

NO APPEARANCE IS NECESSARY OR REQUIRED.
