LR5.7.02 Eligibility, and Registration, Passwords

Attorneys admitted to the bar of this court, including those admitted *pro hac vice*, Federal Public Defenders, and attorneys authorized to represent the United States, may <u>request electronic filing</u> access to the Court through PACER register as Users of the Court's Electronic Filing System. Registration requires the User's name, address, telephone number, Internet e-mail address, and a declaration that the attorney is admitted to the bar of this Court and has received Court approved training in the use of the System. Registration is available through PACER at www.pacer.gov.

Registration as a User constitutes consent to electronic service of all documents as provided in these rules and the Federal Rules.

Once registration is completed, the User will receive notification of his or her log-in and password. User agrees to protect the security of his or her password and immediately notify the clerk if he or she learns the password has been compromised.
