**ORDER AMENDING MEDIATION
CANCELLATION DEADLINE**

Effective this date, the court hereby amends the cancellation provisions set forth under Section 3.II.A of the Case Management Order (“CMO”). The CMO previously stated **“If mediation is canceled with less than 14 days’ notice by either party, the canceling party will pay a \$500 fee to the assigned neutral.”** (emphasis in original). That statement is modified to the following: **“If mediation is canceled with less than 30 days’ notice by either party, the canceling party will pay a \$1000 fee to the assigned neutral.”** This rule applies to all cases proceeding under the CMO.
