ORDER AMENDING LOCAL CRIMINAL RULE 32.2

Appropriate public notice and an opportunity to comment having been given pursuant to Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and pursuant to the majority vote of the active judges of this court,

IT IS ORDERED that the Local Criminal Rules for the United States District Court, Western District of Louisiana, are amended as follows:

LCrR32.2 Presentencing Memoranda

All presentencing memoranda shall be filed by counsel within the time frame designated by the sentencing judge. Access to the memorandum will be selected by the filer during the docket transaction in the electronic record to include appropriate defense and government counsel. The submission of a presentencing memorandum does not relieve the parties from the obligation of providing the probation officer with written objections to the presentence report within 14 days from the day of disclosure in accordance with Fed.R.Cr.P.32(f)(1).
