

S.O. 1.93 Possession and Use of Electronic Devices in the Courthouse

As a result of recent incidents involving the unauthorized use of electronic devices throughout the courthouses of the Western District of Louisiana, a heightened level of security is required with respect to electronic devices.

Accordingly, no cellular phones or other electronic devices are allowed within courthouses by the public, except for lawyers appearing in cases before the Court, jurors, and sworn law enforcement officers. Exceptions to this rule may be made on a case-by-case basis by the presiding judge.
